Pentecost Sunday



The Church is Born!

The motto of our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV is “In Illo uno unum,” which translates to “ In the One, we are one.” This phrase, taken from Saint Augustine’s writings, emphasizes the unity of Christians in Christ. We hear of this unity in our readings for Pentecost.

Pentecost, from a Greek word for “fiftieth,” is the fiftieth and last day of the Easter season. Next week is Trinity Sunday, and then Ordinary Time begins, during which we’ll continue our walk through the Gospel of Luke. Today (at the Mass during the day) we hear from St. Luke in the Acts of the Apostles recounting the Pentecost event, when Jews from all nations and languages hear the gospel being proclaimed in their own language and are amazed.

This was amazing! Human language is unique in its complexity. While other animals communicate using sounds or gestures, only human language allows us to express abstract concepts, discuss past and future events, or share wonderful news like the Good News of Jesus Christ. Language also binds us together into cultures and communities and so we see the Holy Spirit binding the early church together into a new community regardless of origin or language.

At the same time, language can sometimes divide us. At the Vigil Mass we heard from the Book of Genesis, in the Tower of Babel story, humanity’s single language is confused by God, leading to the scattering of people and the multiplication of languages. Leaving aside the question of whether God initiated the multiplication of languages, it is a fitting lesson that sometimes what unites us as a community can also be a source of division if we focus on our differences rather than our similarities. As followers of Christ, we recognize that we are one in our faith in Christ whatever our differences in language, culture, place of origin. A fitting theme for our unity Mass today where our parishes with their differing gifts and services (as recognized in the second reading) are “one in The One.”
